## **FlexTact™ Panels for Tactical Training Facilities**

Hufcor is pleased to announce the launch of the FlexTact™ moveable wall systems used for police, fire, and military tactical training exercise applications.

The FlexTact system has been in development for several years. FlexTact has been refined with input from architects in Columbus, OH, and SchenkelShultz Architects, of Fort Wayne, IN. Market research also included input from police and fire trainers. Projects are now installed in Indiana and Florida with modified Series 600 operable panels.

Basic system highlights include:

1. Overhead track grids based on Type 36 tracks
2. Panels have special rubber edge seals that allow panels to be moved through intersections with minimal takedown.
3. Durable HPL faces with vertical edge trim to withstand simunitions paintball and non-lethal training rounds.
4. Increased downward seal force seal mechanism to keep panels in place.
5. Pass doors with increased downward seal force to secure panels without floor pins.
6. Custom roller latch closures on pass doors for “kick in” exercises

Many states are requiring additional weapons training for police while moving and the FlexTact system provides opportunities to create scenarios for this movement in thousands of local police indoor shooting ranges. Homeland Security training has been mandated for all major U.S. cities and could result in facilities designed specifically for that purpose.
